

	Abu Simbel Temples - The legendary Abu Simbel Temple was created in 1264 BC for the sole purpose of immortalizing the golden heritage of the great king Pharaoh Ramesses the great, honouring Amun-Re, Ptah, and Re-Horakhte through the solar sun phenomenon, eternalizing his win at the epic battle of Kadesh in 1274 BC which ended in the signing of the first peace treaty and showcase his love to his beloved wife Nefertari and children.
	The High Dam - During the modern age in the mid-60s, and 70s the golden Aswan High Dam achieved everlasting greatness and was assigned to make electricity from the flood waters.
	The Unfinished Obelisk - The Great Unfinished Obelisk was on the path of Greatness as it was meant to stand at the Karnak Temple as the biggest obelisk in existence which was meant to reach the high 41.75 meters (137.0 ft) and weigh about 2000 African Elephant to further immortalize the legacy of Queen Hatshepsut (1508 - 1458 BC)
	Philae Temple - The magical Philae temple holds the greatest story ever told about the sacrifice of Isis the goddess of motherhood to her husband the god of the Underworld across its great walls which are found on Agilkia Island which was created in the Ptolemaic era between 380-362 BC during the reign of Nectanebo I plus it was renovated and enlarged on the rule of Ptolemy V Epiphanes, Ptolemy II Philadelphus, and Ptolemy VI Philometor.

EUNCH TO THE PROPERTY OF THE P	Valley of the Kings - In the underground core of the Theban Necropolis on the west bank of the Nile "Valley of the Kings" is the heavenly 63 tombs of the greatest kings, queens, and influential nobles of the New Kingdom (1570 BC - 1544 BC) from the 18th dynasty to the 20th dynasty. The entrance of the valley leads below the ground from a magical hill that looks like the BEN-BEN where the world was created by Atum which is a golden symbol of eternal life and rebirth.
	Hatshepsut Temple - The magical mortuary temple of Queen Hatshepsut (1508–1458 BC) is the greatest example of ancient Egyptian architecture that was created by the vision of Senenmut the royal overseer of the works who honours the creator god Amun-Ra plus it offers an artistic piece showcasing the epic life cycle of Hatshepsut from the time of her coronation till the time of her rebirth. It is made of three great terraces which were carved in the great Deir El Bahari cliffs.
	Colossi of Memnon - The epic Colossi of Memnon has been tested by time since its construction in 1350 BC to offer a golden glimpse into the greatness of Amenhotep III which showcases a number of 107 Roman-era inscriptions dating between 20 & 250 AD in Greek and Latin which tells the great tale of Memnon the Greek mythological king plus it holds carvings dedicated to the god of the Nile Hapi, his wife Tiye and mother Mutemwiya.
	Karnak Temple - The mythical fortified village of the Karnak Temple is the second most visited historical destination which was created in the reign of Senusret I in 1971 BC and lasted all the way till the end of the Ptolemaic Kingdom (305–30 BCE) which earned the title of the most selected of places which became the religious capital of Thebes that Honored the god pf Amum-Re, Mut and Montu that created the Theban triad.

	Valley of the Queens – The valley of the Queens, located near Luxor, is a mesmerizing necropolis that served as the final resting place for queens and royal family members of the New Kingdom era. Explore the intricately decorated tombs adorned with vibrant murals depicting scenes from ancient Egyptian mythology and the afterlife. Marvel at the architectural beauty and historical significance of this UNESCO World Heritage Site, offering a glimpse into the royal burial practices of ancient Egypt.

Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa - The highly rare Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa is a Roman burial ground that became one of the seven wonders of the Middle Ages to house the remains of an ancient family tomb that dates back to the 2nd century AD. It gained overwhelming fame due to its mixture of Egyptian and Roman artistic design and architecture.



Pompey's Pillar - The glorious Pillar of Pompey dates all the way to 302 AD and is known to be the only one of its kind in Egypt. It is an 82-foot (25-meter) granite column made to honor Emperor Diocletian plus it may hold the remains of General Pompey.



Qaitbay Citadel - The blessed citadel of Qaitbey is a majestic fortress constructed in 1477 AD by Sultan Al-Ashraf Qa'it Bay on the coast of the Mediterranean Sea in the same glorious location that once held the great lighthouse of Alexandria. The great citadel is able to display the most incredible collection of Islamic designs and artifacts.



Alexandria Library - Bibliotheca of Alexandria is able to reflect the cultural and historical wealth of the immortal city of Alexandria which was inaugurated in 2002 and filled to showcase a wide collection of the most majestic of books, artifacts, and rare artifacts across the vast history of Egypt from all ages.



El Alamein - Approximately 110 Km away from Alexandria. Proceed to World War II remains and cemeteries, (WW II Cemetery). El Alamein Battle was one of the most significant confrontations of this War. Your first stop during the shore excursion from Alexandria will be at the Military Museum including displays of weapons, military garb, and tanks. Descriptions of the actions of Montgomery, Rommel, and the others who participated in the battle are also on display. Visit the WW II Cemeteries, located on the west of the town, on a small peninsula overlooking the sea. The citadel-like cemeteries are the final resting place for Commonwealth, Greek, Italian and German soldiers.



Morsi Abu Abbas Mosque - This incredible mosque of Abu al-Abbas al-Mursi was built in 1307 AD to offer an insight into the most captivating example of Islamic architectural design and decoration which served as the inspiration for the Sheikh Zayed Mosque in Abu Dhabi.
